

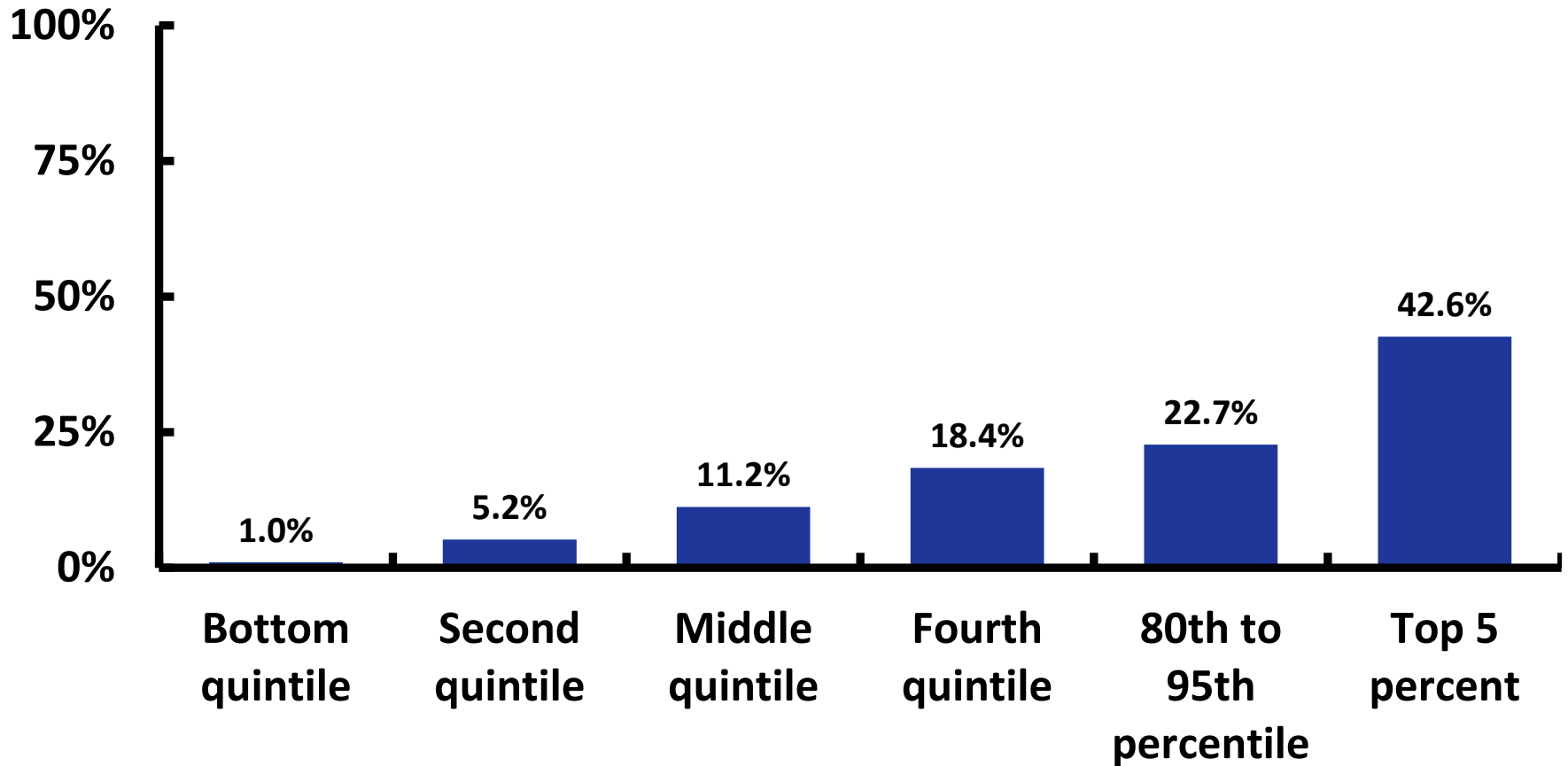

More than 40% of Tax Cuts in the First Year Went to the Top 5%



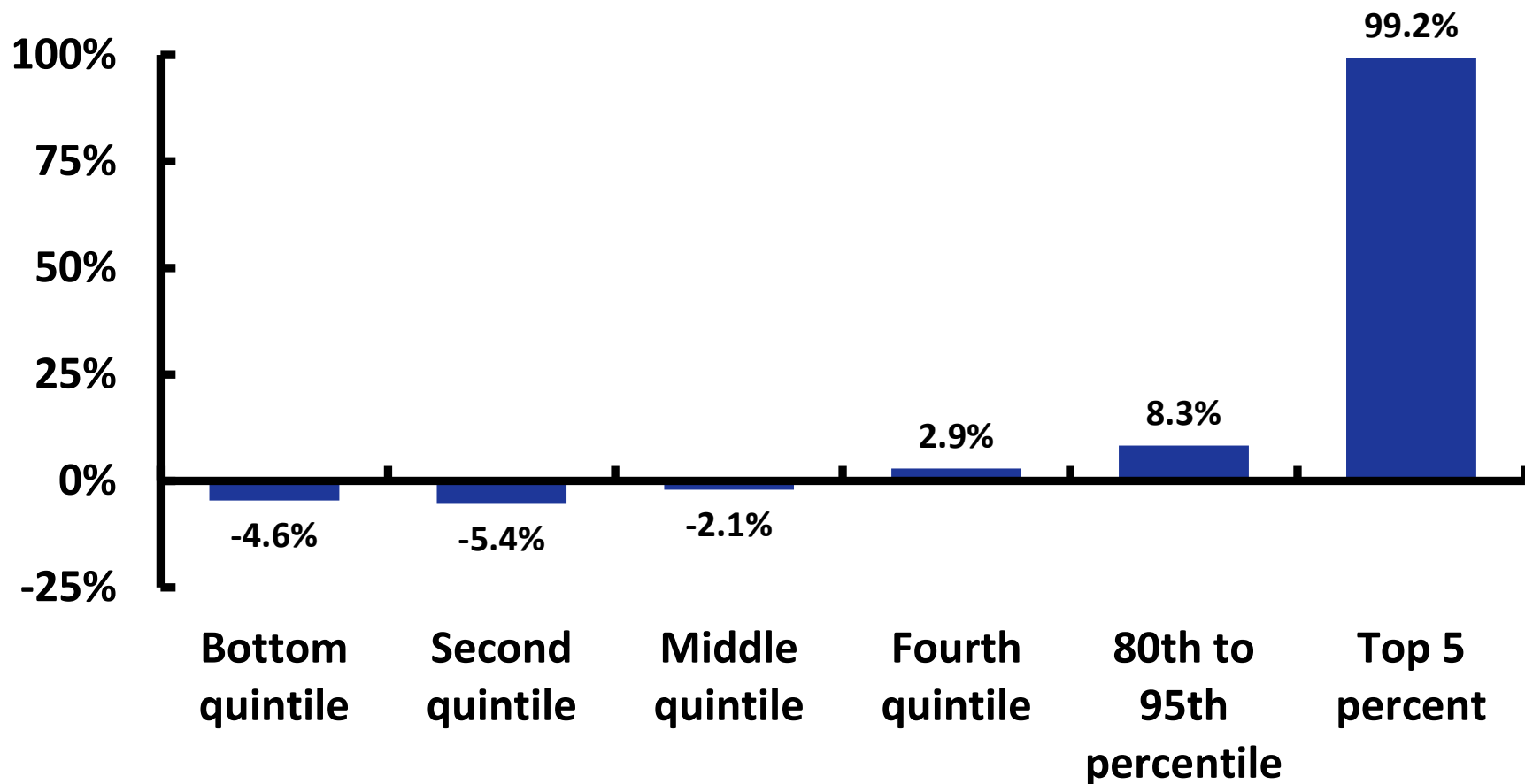

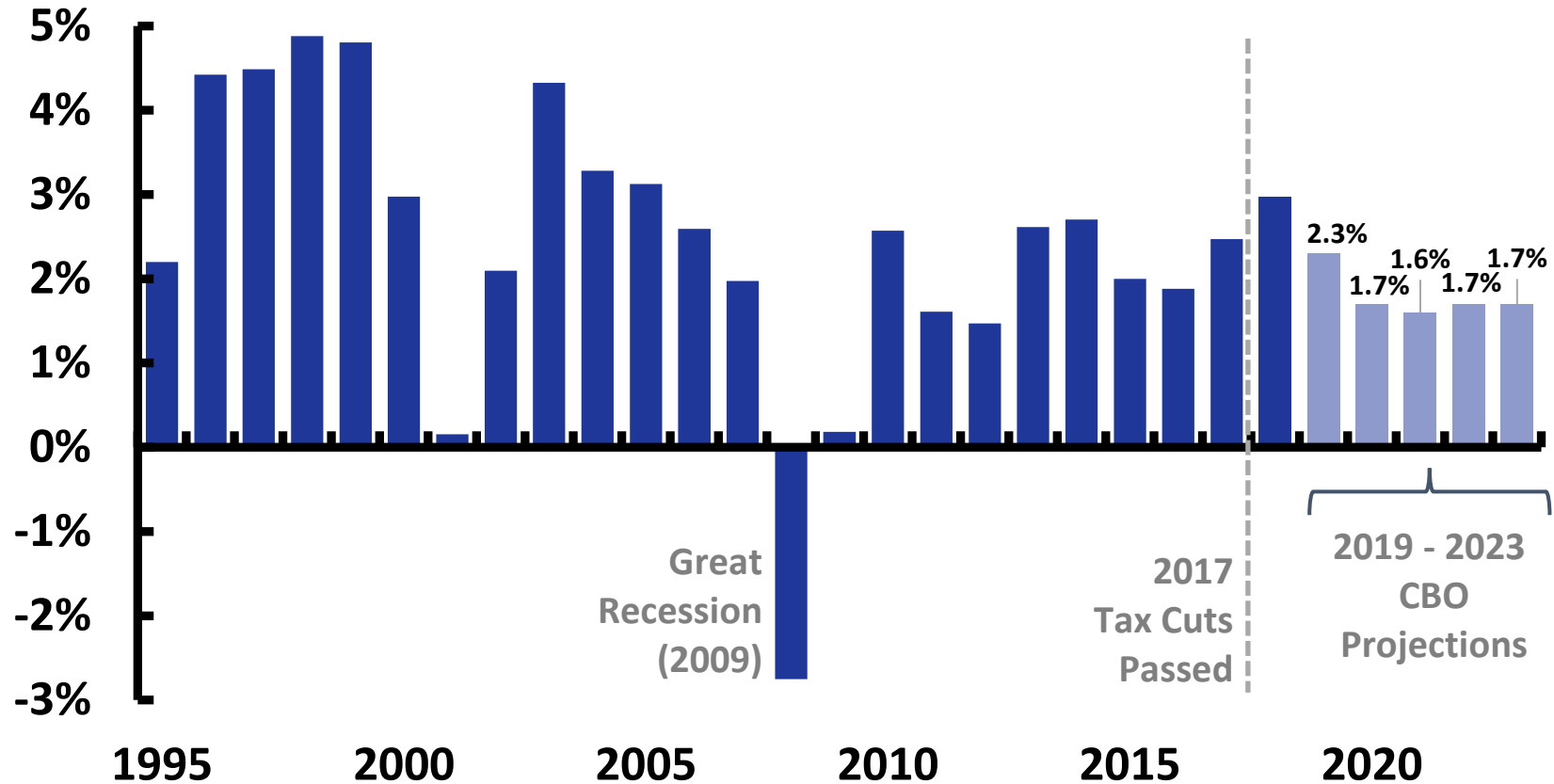

Q4 Over Q4 GDP Growth Rates



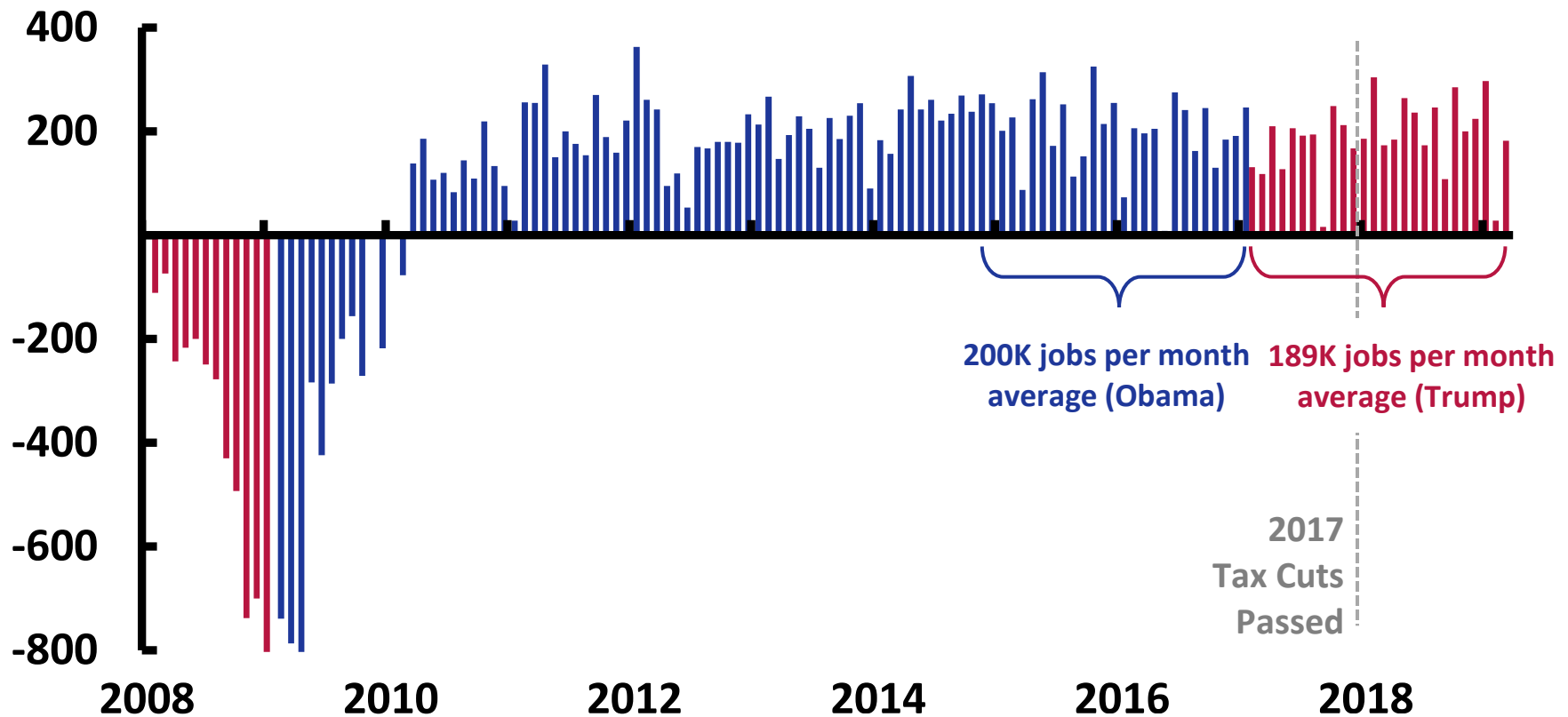

Thousands of Private Sector Jobs, January 2008 to March 2019



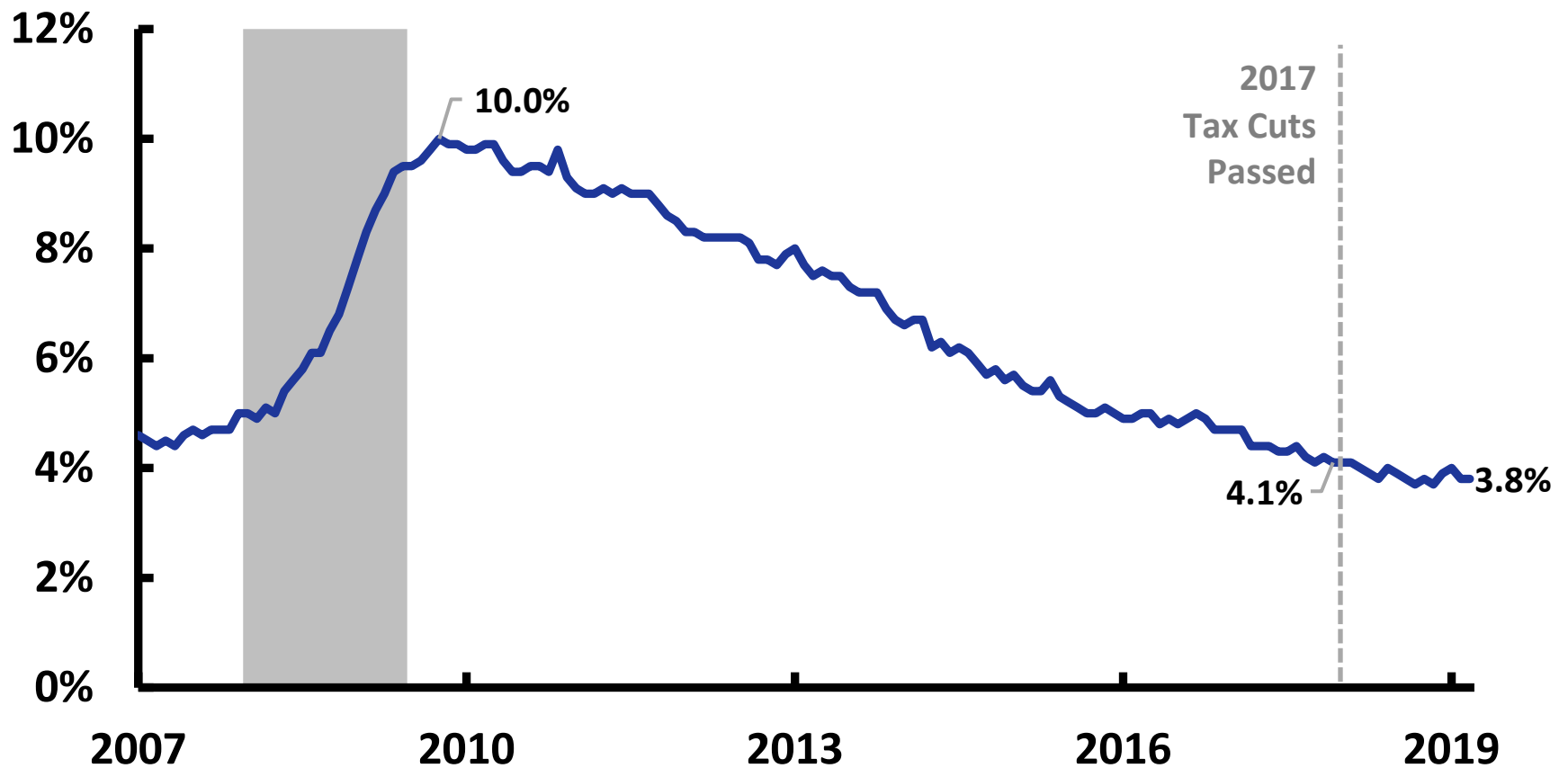

Before the Tax Cuts, the Unemployment Rate Had Already Been Cut in Half



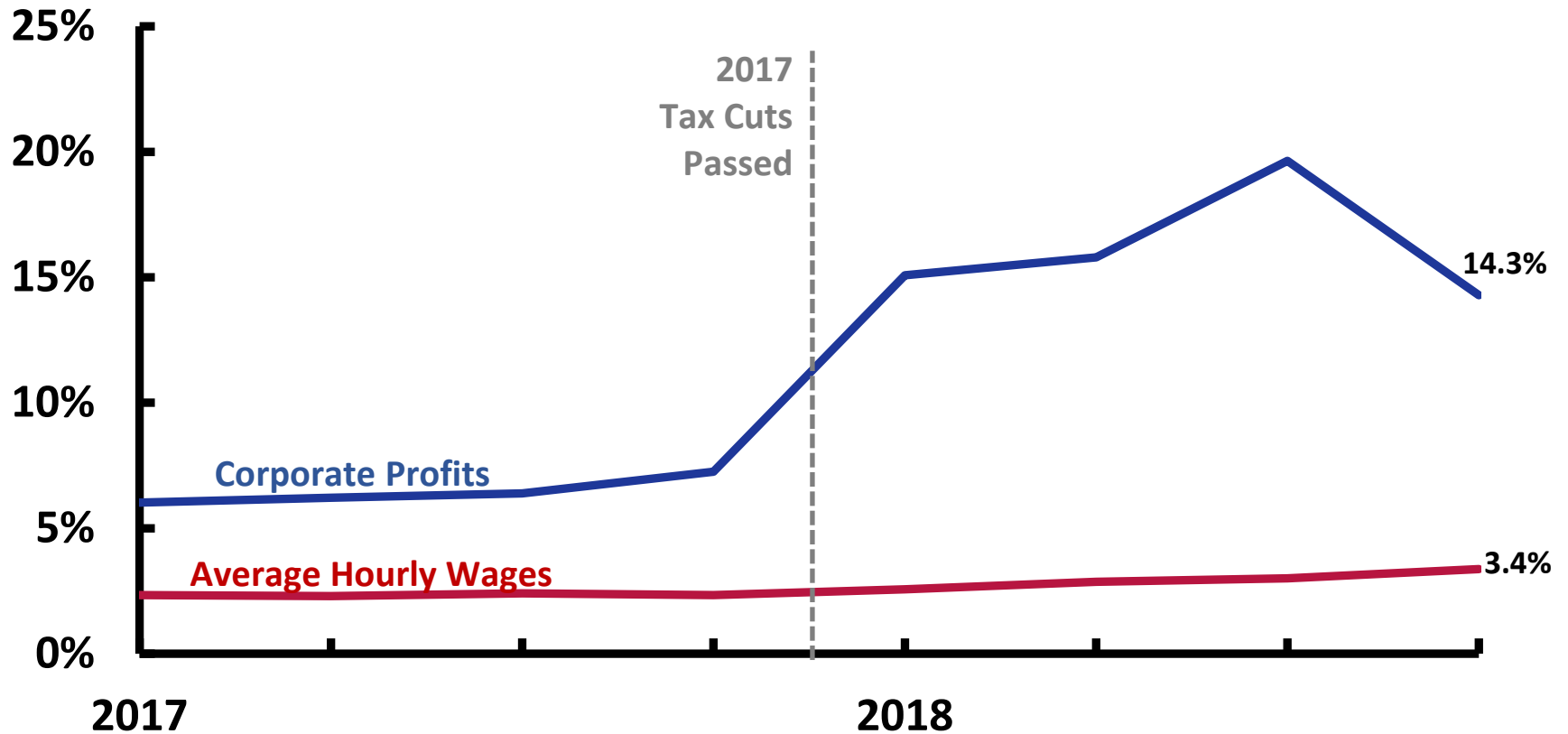

Year Over Year Growth

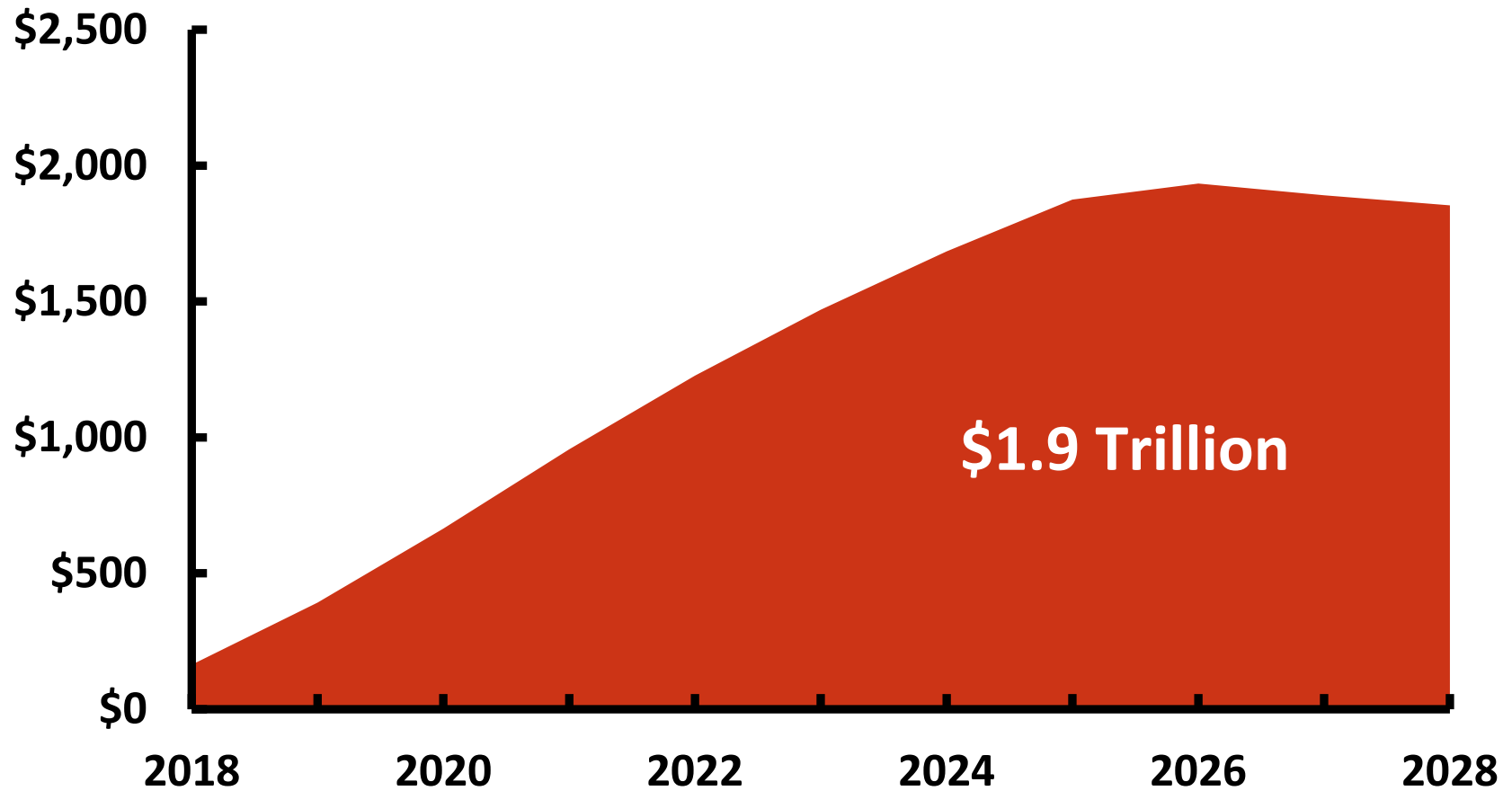

2017 Tax Cuts Projected to Add Almost \$2 Trillion to Federal Debt

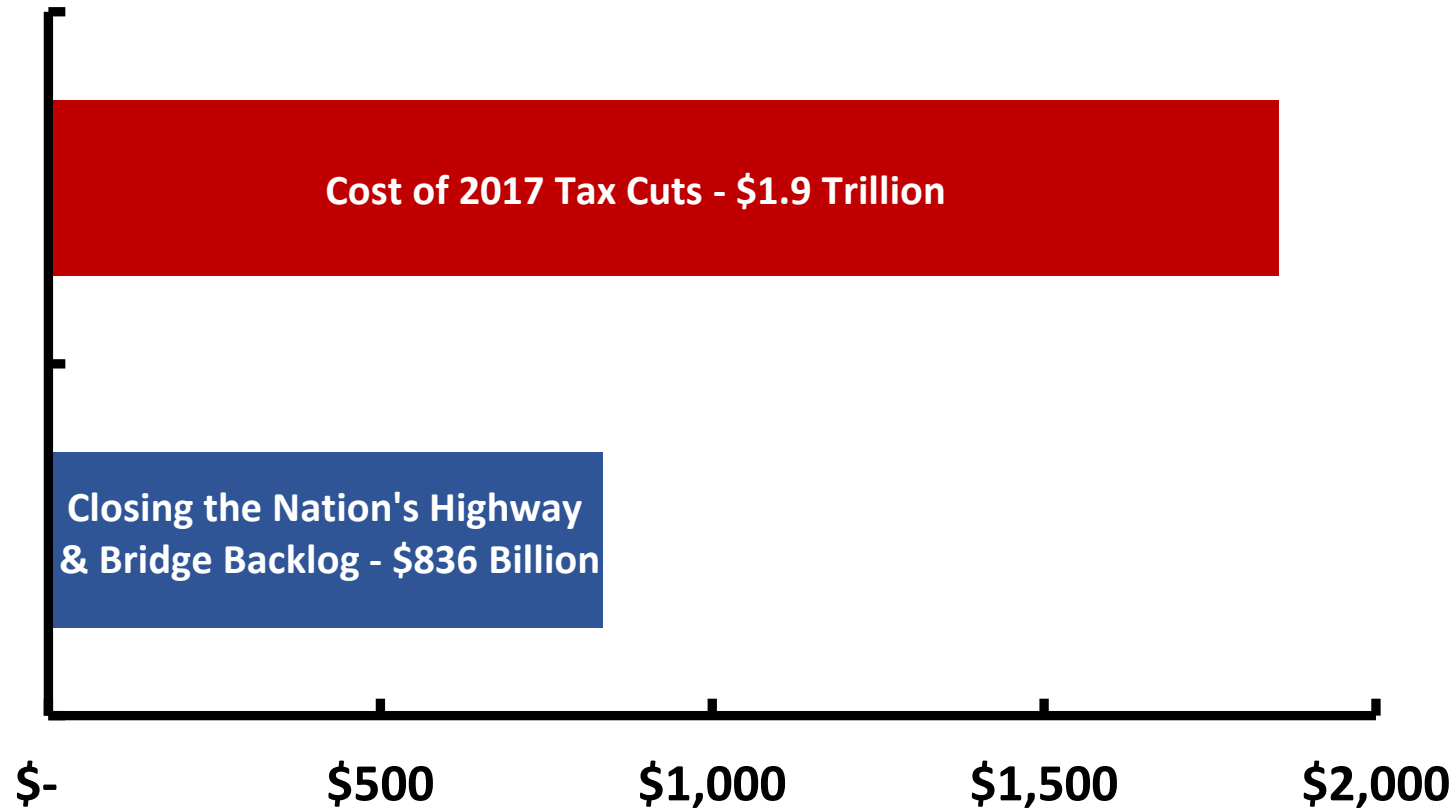
